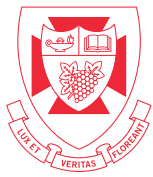


# Teaching Indigenous Languages

In collaboration with the University of Winnipeg and the Indigenous Languages of Manitoba, Teaching Indigenous Languages program was developed to teach courses specific to Anishinaabemowin (Ojibwe) and Ininimowin (Cree).

Through this pilot project, the partners will aim to strengthen education and employment training for Indigenous people and their participation in Canadian society, promote, strengthen and revitalize Indigenous languages and cultures, and foster personal development for Indigenous language speakers, who will then be able to drive projects and training in their own communities and schools.

Graduates of this certificate program will be provided skills to teach Anishinaabemowin or Ininimowin to adult learners in a community program, including Indigenous Languages of Manitoba language classes, as well as other introductory courses.

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### Program Details:

The eight-week program includes 120 classroom hours that focus on Language theory and methodology, as well as 10 hours of observation in a classroom and 10 hours of supervised teaching in a classroom.

### Course Components:

1. Thinking About Theory: A Framework for Indigenous Language Instruction
2. Understanding the Language Classroom Procedures for Effective Teaching
3. Developing the Language System: Teaching Grammar, and Vocabulary and
4. Developing the Language Skills: Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing

**Program Dates:** May 3 to June 30, 2021

**Program Times:** Mon to Thu 6:00 to 9:00 pm & Saturday 10:00 am to 1:00 pm

**Practicum Dates:** July 5 to July 30, 2021 (10 hours of classroom teaching in community classes with Indigenous Languages of Manitoba)
